Palabras clave (or mots-clés): Five keywords must be indicated in the paper's language, separated by semicolons, and each keyword, when composed of multiple words, must not exceed three words. Times New Roman 12, 1.5 spacing, lowercase letters, except for acronyms.

RESUMO

In any case (articles written in French, Spanish, English, and Portuguese), the abstract in Portuguese must be included here with a maximum of 300 characters in Times New Roman 12pt font and justified, 1.5 spacing. In the abstract, clearly state the objective of the article, the steps taken to achieve this objective, and the conclusions of the article.
